Premier Cricket's aim is to ensure your use of the facility is as safe and enjoyable as possible. You **agree** to accept this **Premier Cricket Policies document**. If you do not understand any part of **this** document, please seek clarification.

1. WAIVER, RELEASE AND INDEMNITY

- (a) **ACCEPTANCE OF LEGAL CONTRACT** : You **declare** that you **understand** that this document is a legal contract and is part of the **agreement** to enter the facility and participate in the activities offered. You **understand** this document may affect the right to claim against Premier Cricket in any circumstance.
- (b) **ACCEPTANCE OF RISK AND LIABILITY** : You **agree** and **understand** that you do not enter the playing area or participate in the activities offered unless you **accept** that you do so at your own risk. You **accept** the potential risk of injury or even death to yourself or someone else and / or the potential damage to your own personal property and / or someone else's property. You **accept** the potential liability for injury or even death to yourself or someone else and / or the potential liability for damage to your own personal property and / or someone else's personal property.
- (c) **PLAYER INJURY INSURANCE** : You **accept** that due to rising insurance costs, Premier Cricket no longer carries player injury insurance. Therefore, if you are injured during your practice session, you **accept** that you are required to pay any associated medical costs that arise as a result of your injury.
- (d) **CONCEPT OF WAIVER, RELEASE AND INDEMNITY** : You **agree** that you **understand** the concept of this waiver, release and indemnity. Accordingly, you waive, release and indemnify Premier Cricket and all persons or entities associated with Premier Cricket from any claim, demand or proceeding arising out of your participation in the activities at the facility (including liability).

2. GENERAL (MEMBERS / NON-MEMBERS)

- (a) Please follow any directions given to you by management and / or staff.
- (b) There is a maximum of 4 players per net i.e. 2 nets are to be booked if there are more than 4 players.
- (c) Vacant nets are not for use free of charge. If you use ANY additional nets to those booked, charges will apply at the full hourly non-member rate.
- (d) Equipment is not to be modified or moved in any way unless assisted by a member of staff.
- (e) Premier Cricket supplies balls for the bowling machines. All balls are to be returned to their containers at the conclusion of your session. Non-members are required to supply their own leather cricket balls for bowling.
- (f) Cricket bags are to be stored in the provided bag racks. Premier Cricket accepts no responsibility for the loss of any items whilst your belongings are stored in these racks.
- (g) No smoking and / or alcohol is to be consumed inside or within close proximity of the facility.
- (h) Offensive or abusive language or behaviour is unacceptable whilst inside or in close proximity of the facility. A verbal warning will be given by a staff member. If this unacceptable conduct continues, your session will be terminated and you will be asked to leave the facility and /or the close proximity of the facility immediately.



POLICIES (cont'd)

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- (i) Please arrive in time to allow for any pre session preparation that may be required (padding up, stretching etc). Should your session commence late due to factors not attributable to Premier Cricket, Premier Cricket reserves the right to conclude the session at the scheduled time and charge full fees for that session.
- (j) Safety - Players
 - (i) All players **MUST** wear a helmet at all times whilst batting in the nets.
 - (ii) Players should always play the ball down and into the nets. Repeated lofting of the ball and “slogging” is dangerous and therefore not acceptable. A verbal warning will be given by a staff member. If this unacceptable conduct continues, your session and / or your membership will be terminated and you will be asked to leave the facility and /or the close proximity of the facility immediately.
 - (iii) Players must wear the minimum and necessary protective equipment (2 pads / protector / 2 gloves, helmet).
- (k) Safety - Bowlers

Bowlers need to be aware, at all times, of the possibility of lofted and or returned shots from the batter. All bowlers need to be aware of balls being hit in the adjacent nets at all times.
- (l) Safety - Young Children / Toddlers / Babies

Unless participating in supervised activities (such as a coaching clinic), children under the age of 8 years are not permitted inside the playing area. Children 8 years or over inside the playing area, must be fully supervised by someone 18 years or over. All other children are, at all times, to be fully supervised by someone 18 years or over. Due to safety considerations and limits to space, management respectfully request that no toddlers / babies be brought into the facility.
- (n) Centre Etiquette

To ensure that all who attend the facility feel comfortable at all times, a minimum dress code of closed in shoes, shorts and t-shirts are to be worn at all times. No animals are to be brought inside the facility.

3. FURTHER CONSENTS AND DECLARATIONS

- (a) Medical Treatment
 - (i) In the event of injury arising as a result of your participation in the activities or by reason of your attendance at the facility, you **CONSENT** to appropriate medical treatment being provided to you or organised for you, which may include an ambulance, at no cost or liability to Premier Cricket.
 - (ii) As a parent (or legal guardian), in the event of injury arising as a result of your minor’s participation in the activities or by reason of your minor’s attendance at the facility, you **CONSENT** to appropriate medical treatment being provided to your minor or organised for your minor, which may include an ambulance, at no cost or liability to Premier Cricket.
- (b) Physical Health and Fitness
 - (i) You **DECLARE** that you are physically healthy and fit to participate in the activities at the facility.
 - (ii) As a parent (or legal guardian), you **DECLARE** that your minor is physically healthy and fit to participate in the activities at the facility.
